

Transition to Adult Health Care Timeline

Age	Timeline
At 14	 ✓ Keep records of medical history and maintain medical summary. ✓ Teach your child about his or her diagnosis. ✓ Start thinking and talking about transition from pediatric to adult health care providers.
At 15	✓ Encourage your child to speak up at his/her doctor's appointments.
At 16	 ✓ Encourage your child to spend some alone time with his/her doctor ✓ Ask your child to speak to vocational rehab, counselor, independent living centers within your community, and try job shadowing
At 17	 ✓ Discuss legal options such as guardianship, durable power of attorney for health care, etc. ✓ If on Medicaid start making plans for reapplying
At 18	 ✓ Find out if your child is eligible for SSI ✓ Implement legal options ✓ Take action to transition to adult health care providers ✓ Register to vote ✓ Bridging the gap after graduation ✓ Check your private insurance
At 22	✓ Transition to adult health care providers should be complete unless other provisions are made
